

# Klecker Sommer-OL and Lower-Saxony Championship, Middle distance, August, 12, 2018

## Competition Information and Details

### Travel Information

We recommend to use Autobahn A261, Exit " Tötensen (Rosengarten )" (No. 3). Then turn east towards "Nenndorf". After 1.6 km at the crossroads in Tötensen turn left towards "Hamburg". After 500 m turn right into "Woxdorfer Weg". Follow the signs "Sportplatz" and the given orienteering-signposting.

### Access with public transport

Take Bus 4244 from the train stations "Hamburg-Harburg", "Klecken" or "Buchholz" to "Tötensen, Woxdorfer Weg". The walk to the event centre is about 400 m. Follow the signs "Sportplatz" and the given orienteering-signposting. For further information see [www.hvv.de](http://www.hvv.de).

### Event Centre (WKZ)

The event centre is located on the sports grounds in Tötensen. The starting documents will be handed out in the club house. The read-out of the SI-cards, toilets and a limited number showers are also located there.

The finish area is located 50 m away from the club house on a meadow. The result lists and catering are located there.

### Parking

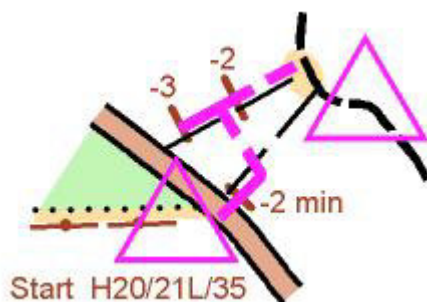
The parking area of the sport grounds can be used for parking. Additional parking areas are located 200 m away, the surrounding streets can be used as well. Please follow the instructions of the parking personnel and keep all gateways free. The distance from the parking areas to the event centre is about 50 to 300 m.

### Start

First Start 10:30 am

Distance event centre – start: 1650 m, 20 m climbing. The way to the start uses roads and cycle tracks and is marked with white/orange tapes.

Call-up will be 3 minutes before the start. Competitors of the classes **H20/H21L/H35** have a different start location. They will get their map after crossing the street.



The classes **H/D 10 and H/D10b** have their own start located on the west end of the finish area. Competitors of this classes have free starting time after 11:00 am.

## Control descriptions

Control description sheets are available at the start (2 min before the start).  
Additionally the description printed on the maps.

## Finish

Drinks are available at the finish.  
The finish closes at 2:00 pm

## Reading out of SI-Cards

SI-Cards are read out in the club house 50 m from the finish area.

## Map

Scale 1:10 000, equidistance 5 m, version June 2018, size A4.

The following classes receive maps with different scale:

**scale 1:7500:** D/H55, D/H65, H75,

**scale 1:5000:** D/H 10 and D/H 10b

The orienteering-map "Sunder-Süd", first used in 2016, has been extended and extensively revised. Most of the classes only use the new, northern part.

## Special symbols:

**X** (black) little hut made out of branches or broken shooting platform.

The control description also shows an **X**.

## Terrain

The competition area is a glacial formed terrain in a height from 40 to 90 m. The terrain is characterized by many valleys and hollows with short, steep climbs of 10-15 m. Beech and coniferous forests alternate. The runnability is limited in some places due to denser vegetation and soil-vegetation (such as ferns). This applies in particular in the first part of the courses (for the classes H20/21L/35 after crossing the street). The vegetation is indicated accordingly (green striped areas). In the course of the competition, however, the forests runnability increases! Towards the end of the race, the participants can expect an open beech forest.

Extensive forestry work has been carried out in the forest area over the last year. Therefore, there are many less visible wood-extraction-traces and stacks of wood which are not shown on the map. Root stocks are not shown on the map. Stones are on the map from a size of 70 cm.

## Mandatory marked route

All courses (except D/H 10 and D/H 10b) have to take a taped route between two forest areas. This route is 380 m long with 15 m climb. All competitors must follow the marked route until they cross a street.

Competitors of the classes **H20/21L/35** will cross another street about 2 km after their start. The transition can be made at different locations depending on the route choice. There is no traffic regulation. Please pay attention to vehicles!

A special **children-course** ("Kinder-OL") is available. It is performed as a score-orienteeing in the finish area.

### Championship (Lower-Saxony)

This competition is also the Lower-Saxony championship for long-distance orienteeing.

### Prize Giving Ceremony

The prize giving ceremony will take place in the event centre, after the competition about 2:15 pm.

There are small prizes for the first three competitors in each class, as well as medals and certificates for the Lower-Saxony championship.

### Food

SC Klecken offers cake, sausages (with and without potato salad), coffee and drinks in the event centre.

### Toilets

There is a toilet in the club house at the event centre as well as toilet cabins nearby.

### Accommodation

In the sports hall in Klecken, "Hainbuchenweg", sleeping on hard floor is available for the participants by pre-registration. The accommodation is on the gallery (2nd floor). Please get the documents in the event centre.

Parking space for mobile homes at the sports hall on request.

In the sports hall on the day of the normal sports activity takes place.
